
North Field Taxiway B & Runway 10R-28L Rehabilitation Project

- ♦ Occurs every 15 to 20 Years; last completed in 2008
- ★ Critical Pavement, Safety, & Electrical Infrastructure Improvements
- ★ Airfield Safety Infrastructure Improvements
- ★ New LED Lighting Safety Improvements
- ★ Resiliency, Grading, & Drainage Improvements
- ★ Safety Enhancements Encourage Compliance with OAK Noise Abatement Procedures

★ Approximately 40 to 50 Jet departures per Day will occur on North Field due to Taxiway B Closure; majority during daylight hours. Estimated departures include:





Taxiway B Open
November 2025 – 5 to 7 Consecutive Nightly Closures
Note – Taxiway B Nightly Closures - *9 PM – 4 AM*

North Field Operations (Estimated Impacts)

- ★ Minimal to no impacts are anticipated when North Field Taxiway B is closed nightly.
 - ★ Departures during these hours are typically only Lifeguard Medical or Law Enforcement
